Technical & Design Advantages

SHINNOKI® is a prefinished wood veneer adhered to a phenolic laminate backing sheet. The SHINNOKI® range amplifies sophistication and opulence with six layers of a matte finish ultralow emitting acrylate urethane UV-cured varnish partnered with a rolling technique and intermediate curing, enhancing the texture of the natural wood veneer. With the six-layer varnishing process the prefinished laminate provides ultimate scratch resistance against micro scratches without impacting the finish and colour. SHINNOKI® is available as a finished panel on a 3000mm x 1200mm EO MR MDF substrate at the thickness of your choice. All decors have matching prefinished, unglued veneer edge banding.

Exposure to Sunlight

SHINNOKI® laminates are made from natural timbers and will react to direct and indirect sunlight. The pre-finished surface contains a UV protection that offers some protection against discolouration, but like all natural wood products, colour variation will occur over time. Excessive exposure to direct sunlight may cause timber veneers to undergo sudden and irregular colour changes.

Environmental

SHINNOKI® veneer are an environmentally sustainable choice, as respect for nature and ecologically sound business practices are a key value of our supplier. All wood-based aspects are sourced from a responsible forestry and utilise mix match technology when processing veneers to ensure maximum yield and efficiency.

Veneer Grain & Characteristics

As the SHINNOKI® range is made from natural timber veneer, sheets may display natural features such as pin knots, gum, mild-indentations, and variances in curve direction of grain and off-centred crowns. Additionally, stock can vary in appearance within a sheet and between different sheets between batches and from samples to actual current stock. These are not classed as defects but purely intrinsic features of the veneer and process. SHINNOKI® grain runs vertically along the length of panel.

Cleaning & Maintenance

SHINNOKI® surfaces are easy to clean. For removing dust or small particles, use a soft, dry cloth. Tough dirt can be simply removed using a cloth dampened with warm water and detergent. If in doubt about a particular cleaning product or detergent, check with the manufacturer for suitability. Avoid the following when cleaning, as these substances and materials could damage the finish and make the surface susceptible to staining:

- Acetone or trichloroethylene
- Abrasive cleaners, harsh detergents and powders
- Scouring pads, steel wool and sandpaper
- Ceramic cooktop cleaners
- Bathroom and tile cleaners
- Chlorine bleach

Accidental spills or splatters of any harsh substance should be wiped off immediately and the area cleaned thoroughly with a damp cloth.
